

## ACCESS EXTRA SCHOLARSHIP

### 2024-2025

*a private scholarship for high school seniors  
award up to \$2,000 per academic year*

#### PROGRAM

A private scholarship for students with a Student Aid Index of 12,000 or less and who have earned a cumulative 3.50 or higher on a 4.0 scale weighted or unweighted GPA through at least seven semesters at a Missouri high school.

#### APPLY EARLY

- **PLEASE NOTE: We have pushed back the opening of our Access EXTRA Scholarship due to announced delays by Federal Student Aid. Students need their FAFSA Submission Summaries to apply for this scholarship.**
- Scholarship opportunity opens April 1, 2024 on My Scholarship Central.
- Application closes May 15, 2024 or until funding is depleted. Awards are prioritized first-come, first-served.

#### ELIGIBILITY

- Missouri resident.
- 2024 high school seniors who will be enrolled full-time at an eligible Missouri public or private higher education institution in the fall of 2024. See eligible schools list.
- Have a Student Aid Index (SAI) of 12,000 or less as determined on the FAFSA, which is a similar requirement for the state's Access Missouri Financial Assistance Program.
- Earned a cumulative 3.50 or higher on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent on another scale) weighted or unweighted GPA through at least seven semesters at a Missouri high school. Please note, in order to qualify the GPA will need to be converted to a 4.0 scale.

#### APPLICATION PROCESS

- Before you start, you will need a copy of your FAFSA Submission Summary generated from the FAFSA and your high school transcript through at least seven semesters (through fall semester of your senior year).
- Go to [myscholarshipcentral.org/apply](https://myscholarshipcentral.org/apply) and click "Apply Now".
- On the top right of the page, click "Sign In" if you already have a My Scholarship Central account, or "Sign Up" if you've never used the site.
- Enter your email and password. If you are a new user, you will receive a confirmation email and must click the link in the email to validate your account. Use an email address that you will have access to after you graduate from high school.
- Complete the General Application if you have not done so this year.
- After submitting the General Application, you should see the Access EXTRA Scholarship on your list of Recommended Opportunities. If not, click "Opportunities" in the blue bar and choose "Ours." Search "Access EXTRA".
- Click the orange "Apply" button next to the opportunity name. After completing the application, click "submit" at the bottom right of the page.

#### ADDITIONAL STUDENT INFORMATION

- Scholarships are available on a first come, first served basis and are at the discretion of Missouri Scholarship & Loan Foundation (MSLF) in accordance with program rules and applicable law. All scholarship applications will be considered, provided that funding is available.
- Program funding will be determined annually by MSLF. The scholarship is renewable for up to a total of four years. If funding is available, eligible previous recipients will be invited to apply for renewal using a special application.
- Applicants will be notified if a scholarship is awarded via My Scholarship Central. The scholarship must be used to cover the Cost of Attendance as determined by the school.
- If awarded the scholarship, the amount may be reduced if your unmet need (i.e., your Cost of Attendance minus other scholarships and grants) is less than the scholarship.
- If this award is used for educational expenses that are not required for your academic program, such as housing, meals or transportation, your scholarship may be considered taxable income. You should consult your tax advisor about your specific situation.
